






#### Who we are

Our work enables accelerated impact for SDG 6.2, which aims to provide "access to adequate and equitable sanitation and hygiene for all and end open defecation, paying special attention to the needs of women and girls and those in vulnerable situations by 2030." With LIXIL, our goal is to improve the lives of 100 million people by 2025, through improved sanitation and hygiene.



#### Flexible solutions for schools



Our innovative products are designed to meet the variety of needs in school premises. Our portfolio enables a brand-new installation or the retrofitting of toilets, with the option to use SATO Pan for squatting and the SATO Stool for sitting and access for those with reduced mobility. Our V-trap and I-trap systems are designed for off-set solutions and encourage safely managed sanitation. The newest addition, our SATO Tap, supports hand-hygiene programmes in school.

## How SATO supports Rotary's strategy



Besides impacting directly one of Rotary's causes 'Providing Clean Water, Sanitation and Hygiene', SATO and school sanitation are in direct relationship with many other causes, such as 'Supporting education', 'Fighting Disease' and 'Protecting the Environment'. As a social business, we are also growing local economies and supporting mothers and children through improved sanitation and hygiene.

## Africa: improving school sanitation and hygiene with STEP

In 2020, we launched the School Toilet Enhancement Program (STEP) an initiative that upgrades toilets in Africa. Through STEP, we are aiming to reduce one of the barriers to school attendance – inadequate sanitation and hygiene facilities. STEP is our flagship programme that raises awareness about sanitation and hygiene, engaging communities and inspiring households, other schools and governments to improve their facilities. So far, 43 schools have been upgraded and over 72,000 children have benefitted.



## Partnering with Rotary in Kenya

Students at St. Michaels Primary School in Embu, Central Kenya, are now experiencing the benefits of improved sanitation since the school has upgraded 47 toilets in 2022. The result of the upgrade with the Rotary Club of Embu is odour free, safe toilets and a better life every day for the staff and the 750 school children, including the ones with disability thanks to the installation of the SATO stool.


## SATO Tap performs well in schools

In cooperation with two large elementary schools in Quezon City, Philippines, GIZ measured the water consumption of several hand washing solutions and found that the SATO Tap had "very low" consumption in controlled settings and used 91% less water per wash compared with a conventional tap and 72% less water per wash compared with an improvised tap. Besides that, the SATO Tap had the greatest number of uses during the test, making it the most exciting solution for kids.
